The National Pesticide Information Retrieval System (NPIRS) is a collection of pesticide-related websites available by subscription. NPIRS is under the administration of the Center for Environmental and Regulatory Information Systems (CERIS) at Purdue University in West Lafayette, Indiana.

Many subscribers use NPIRS to assist in registering pesticides and developing market strategies based on currently registered products or pending registrations.
